The North Bend Community Scholarship Fund, Inc. is a non-profit, public-benefit, 501 (c) (3) tax exempt Oregon corporation that is organized to 1) receive gifts and bequests, 2) invest designated funds, and 3) disburse earnings and / or special gifts as grants or scholarships to qualified North Bend High School graduates. Award amounts are determined individually by the Selection Committee based on one or more of these criteria: *ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE, SPECIAL MERIT, FINANCIAL NEED*. Some programs emphasize one criterion while other programs consider all criteria equally.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: FRIDAY, APRIL 2, 2010
All materials are due by 4:30 p.m. on the deadline day.

 The completed application must be mailed or hand-delivered.

- *If the application is mailed, be sure it is in the mail in **adequate time to arrive by the deadline**. An April 2 postmark does not meet the deadline requirement. An application not received by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, April 2 will be returned unopened.
- *If you wish notification that your application has been received on time, include a stamped, self-addressed postcard. Use only a **regular postcard**, no substitute.
- *Submit two sets of pages 1 –14 in appropriate term paper style folders. One set is the original / the second set may be photocopies of original materials.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

1. Be a graduate (any year) of North Bend High School or be a senior at NBHS at time of application.
2. Have attended NBHS a minimum of two years (four semesters / six terms).
3. Complete and submit appropriate application by deadline time.
4. Enroll in accredited United States college/university or technical/vocational school eligible to accept federal financial aid money.

ENDOWED PROGRAMS / SPECIAL PROGRAMS ELIGIBILITY

1. Meet General Eligibility requirements.
2. Meet specific eligibility requirements of the Endowed or Special Program.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

The North Bend Community Scholarship Fund, Inc. currently administers 30 individual programs which are listed on the following sheets. A brief description of each program is included; however, several may carry additional criteria. If you have questions, write the NBCSF Selection Committee at address given above. Additional awards may be added at any time as new programs are established.

The Selection Committee matches applicants to eligibility criteria, so an applicant needs to submit only two sets of forms to be considered for all programs for which he/she might be eligible.
