Esther LaClair-Probst Fund	Preference given to study in vocational fields
Beverly Slaney Nelson Estate	Preference given to study of fine arts, especially visual arts
Forrest & Pauline Perry Estate	Financial need considered for a student with well-defined career goal. Technology/vocational programs equal importance to college/university
Pittam Family Trust	Preference to NBHS senior planning to major in elementary education
Jason Poppe Memorial	Graduating senior, high academics & personal standards, athletic participant, to major in science, math, engineering or related field, preference to OSU
Fred William Probst Estate	Consideration given all candidates regardless of school or field of study
Olive Beaudry Probst Memorial	Limited to SWOCC, includes minimum \$1,000 award per year for two years, renewable for second year with reapplication and qualifications
Mark Sandberg Music Memorial	For NBHS senior to study music at Oregon college/university, preference to UofO
Schepman/Gebhardt Fund	No specific criteria established beyond general eligibility

Frank Shriver Memorial	Recognizes student planning to attend or currently enrolled at an Oregon college/university to major in secondary teaching, coaching, or counseling
Hilda "Johnnie" Shriver Memorial	Preference to student currently admitted/enrolled in professional nursing or related program at an Oregon community college or university
Stinchfield Family	Preference to health-related career choice, including mental health
Vivian Shriver Thompson	Recognizes college junior or senior at an Oregon school (preference to OSU) enrolled in wide variety of environmental study areas
Vivian Shriver Thompson	Preference to Oregon State University junior or senior in College of Home Economics and Education, majoring in nutrition or dietetics
Aimee Why Memorial	Preference to junior or senior in Oregon state-supported college/university majoring in pre-dentistry, dental hygiene, or science

F. Willis Smith Fund	Endowed through the Oregon Community Foundation to make yearly contributions of interest earned. No specific criteria established beyond general NBCSF eligibility
Flaxel Family	Recognizes a dedicated NBHS graduating athlete who has maintained adequate grades and demonstrated good sportsmanship. No requirement of planned college athletics
'Nurse Nancy' Scholarship	Preference to study in professional nursing, but other health related fields considered
Maybelle M. Olson Estate	Jr. or Sr. enrolled in elementary education at 4-yr. university, financial need and GPA considered
Chapter CS of PEO Sisterhood	For continuing education after 72 college credit hours earned
Heidi Johnson Memorial	Study at Oregon college/university with preference to Lane C.C., with no restriction on degree field
Gene Pierce Memorial	For study of public safety, with preference to law enforcement

NOTIFICATION

1. NBHS seniors receiving scholarships will be notified at Senior Awards Night during graduation week.
2. Past graduates receiving scholarships will be notified by mail during the week after graduation.
3. Past graduates will be asked to pick up or have a relative pick up their award packets at the home of the NBCSF treasurer.

TRANSFER OF FUNDS

1. Absolute deadline for return of the information form included in the packet is Sept. 3, 2010
2. Failure to meet Sept. 3, 2010 deadline results in loss of scholarship.
3. A copy of your financial aid award letter is required before transfer of any funds.
4. Awards are disbursed to you on a term- by- term basis. The entire amount may not be used the first term.
5. It is the policy of the NBCSF to not grant monies in excess of the budgetary cost set by your school.
